



Dear User,

In accordance with art. 13 EU Regulation 2016/679 (hereinafter, "GDPR"), we inform you that the processing of data by you provided will be carried out with methods and procedures aimed at ensuring that the processing itself is compliant with fundamental rights and freedoms, with special attention to confidentiality and security, to personal identity and the right of data protection.

Remember that "processing" means any operation or set of operations which is performed on personal data or on sets of personal data, whether or not by automated means, such as collection, recording, organisation, structuring, storage, adaptation or alteration, retrieval, consultation, use, disclosure by transmission, dissemination or otherwise making available, alignment or combination, restriction, erasure or destruction( Article 4 GDPR).

### 1 What are cookies?

Cookies are small text files sent to the user by the visited website. They are stored on the hard disk of the computer, thus allowing the website to recognize users and store certain information about them, in order to allow or improve the service offered.

There are different types of cookies. Some are necessary to browse the site, others have different purposes, such as ensuring internal security, administer the system, perform statistical analysis, understand which sections of the website users are more interested in or offer a personalized visit of the website.

The Website uses technical and non-profiling cookies. The foregoing refers to both the user's computer and any other device that the user can use to connect to the Site.

#### Technical cookies

Technical cookies are those used for the sole purpose of transmitting a communication over an electronic communication network, or to the extent strictly necessary for the provider of a service explicitly requested by the subscriber or user to provide such service.

They are not used for other purposes and are normally installed directly by the owner or manager of the website.

They can be divided into:

- navigation or session cookies, which guarantee the normal navigation and use of the website (allowing, for example, to make a purchase or authenticate to access restricted areas);
- analytics cookies, similar to technical cookies when used directly by the website manager to collect aggregate information, regarding the number of users and how they brows the site;
- Functional cookies, which allow the user to navigate according to a series of selected criteria (for example, the language, the products selected for purchase) in order to improve the service provided.

#### Profiling cookies

Profiling cookies are designed to create profiles related to the user and are used in order to send advertising messages in line with the preferences expressed by user himself during the internet browsing. The consent of the data subject is required for the use of profiling cookies. According with the provision n. 229 of 8 May 2014, the user must be able to authorize or refuse consent to install profiling cookies if they are present.

In case of third-parts cookies, the website does not have direct control of each individual cookie and cannot control them (it can neither install them directly nor delete them). It is possible, however, to manage these cookies through the browser settings (follow the instructions given below), or the sites indicated in the "Managing cookies" section.

Disabling cookies may limit the ability to use the website and prevent you from fully enjoy the website features and services. To decide which ones to accept and which to refuse, a description of the cookies used on the Website is shown below.

### 2 Types of cookies used

#### First-part cookies

First-part cookies (i.e. cookies that belong to the publisher's website that created them) are set by the website visited by the user, whose address appears in the URL window. The use of these cookies allows us to make the website work efficiently and to track visitor behaviour patterns.

#### Third parts cookies

Third-parts cookies are set by a domain different from the one visited by the user.

Third-parts cookies are present If a user visits a website and a different company sends information using that site.

#### Session cookies

Session cookies are stored temporarily and are deleted when the user closes the browser. If you register an account on a website, you may use cookies that collect personal data in order to identify you on



subsequent visits and to facilitate the login (for example, keeping your username and password) and browsing as well. Furthermore, JK GROUP S.P.A. uses cookies for system administration purposes. The Site may contain links to other sites. JK GROUP S.P.A. has no access or control over cookies, web beacons and other tracking technologies used on third-party websites that the user can access from its website, neither on availability, on any content and material that is published or obtained through such websites and on the relative methods of processing personal data. On this regard, JK GROUP S.P.A., considering the amount of such third-party websites, expressly declines any related liability. The user should check the privacy policy of third-party websites accessed from the JK GROUP's website to know the conditions applicable to the processing of personal data as the JK GROUP S.P.A. Privacy Policy applies only to this website, as defined above.

Persistent cookies

Persistent cookies are stored on user's devices between browser sessions, allowing to remember user preferences or actions on a website. They can be used for different purposes, for example to remember preferences and choices when using the website.

Essential cookies

These cookies are strictly necessary for the functioning of the website. Without the use of such cookies some parts of it would not work. They include, for example, cookies that allow access to protected areas of the website. These cookies do not collect information for marketing purposes and cannot be deactivated.

Functional cookies

These cookies are used to recognize a user who returns to browse the website. They allow the user to customize the contents and remember its preferences (for example, the selected language or region). These cookies do not collect information that can identify you. All information collected is anonymous.

Cookies shared on Social Networks

These cookies facilitate the sharing of website content through social networks such as Facebook, Twitter and LinkedIn. To view the respective privacy and cookies policies you can visit the websites of social networks.
